SAN FRANCISCO INTERNATIONAL AIRPORT (SFO)

San Francisco International Airport is 13 miles south of downtown San Francisco. It has flights to destinations throughout North America and is a major gateway to Europe and Asia. SFO is the largest airport in Northern California.

OAKLAND INTERNATIONAL AIRPORT (OAK)

Oakland International Airport is five miles south of downtown Oakland. The airport has passenger service to cities in the United States, Mexico, and Europe. The most common airlines at OAK are Southwest Airlines, Alaska Airlines, Spirit Airlines, Hawaiian Airlines, and JetBlue Airways.

SACRAMENTO INTERNATIONAL AIRPORT (SMF)

Sacramento International Airport is 10 miles northwest of downtown Sacramento. SMF is served by 15 airlines offering more than 170 daily flights to over 40 nonstop destinations across the US, Canada, Mexico, and Hawaii. Southwest Airlines is the largest carrier, followed by American, Delta, and United.

SONOMA COUNTY AIRPORT - CHARLES M. SCHULTZ (STS)

The Sonoma County Airport features a single terminal that is primarily serviced by Alaska Airlines. It offers flights to San Francisco, Los Angeles, Orange County, San Diego, Portland, Seattle, Phoenix, Las Vegas, and Minneapolis.

DRIVING

From San Francisco, HWY 101 provides access to Calistoga. From the south and east, HWY 8 to HWY 29 is the most widely used route. The Silverado Trail, which parallels HWY 29, offers an alternate route when HWY 29 is congested. Please consult a map to determine the best route for you.
